I have the privilege to present the annual report 2018-19 of Jamia Nadwiyya Training college, with a brief out line of our activities and accomplishments. Jamia Nadwiyya Training college is one of the prestigious teacher education institution in the state of Kerala managed by the Jamia Nadwiyya Trust board. It was established in 1995 as a self financing teacher education institution affiliated to university of Calicut. It is also recognized by the NCTE Bangalore

1.Intake and admission procedure

BED programme shall be of a duration of two academic years . NCTE sanctioned two basic units of 100 students to the college but to maintain quality the college admitted 50 students only this year

Admission was made on the basis of marks of the candidates applied online to the university.

2.Staff

The sraff consist of 1 principal, eight lecturers and four Non teaching staff. The appointment of teachers was to ensure availability of expertise for teaching foundation and methodology courses. Thus we have 3 general teachers and five optional subject teachers to handle the 5 optional subject viz Arabic, English, Natural Science, Physical Science and Social science. The present strength of students are 49 in senior batch and 50 in junior batch

Mr.Jayadevan and Mr.Jaleel left the college and smt Sumayya and sri Ajeesh joined this year .Smt.Sumayya KT joined the college in the vacancy of Saifunneesa who left the service of the college during the previous academic year .The subject wise strength is as follows .

A smart room and sufficient number of computers / laptops to each class room is required .4.To keep the question paper safe an Iron safe is required .5 Library may be extended by demolishing the partition wall between the rooms .6 More racks may provided to the library.7 Some teachers are not fully qualified and Physical education and fine arts teachers are not available . 8 Working days and working time are not adequate as per the norms of the NCTE.(Due to Nippa ,flood and harthal 9 No printing of prospectus and syllabus or college magazine was made this year .10 No teachers are voluntarily engaging NET, SET or KTET coaching and they are not willing to remain in the college after the bell for academic matters 11 No UPS battery or generator available 12 In-service course

seminars and conferences not organized 13. Some books based on the revised curriculum may be purchased.

Threats

1.Showcase notice by NCTE has been served for strict compliance of norms of NCTE 2 .Some teachers are likely to leave and hence advertisements .need to be made soon

Opportunities

1.Efforts are being made for accreditation which may improve our image 2 .Without harvesting rain water water scarcity cannot be done away with 3 Solar panel can be established to minimize current expenditure. We yet to complete some of the programmes like sports literary competition, community living camp etc. We hope those activity can also be undertaken in the near future.
